The purpose of this committee is to advise HBC on the various elements, processes and deliverables of the HI Infrastructure Plan against which all development will be evaluated and managed.

We continue to be disappointed that our suggestions and advice in the main are filtered or disregarded, and not acknowledged or favoured with a response.

Specifically, in the case of the next meeting:

- A3023 analysis including capacity and future growth
- Drainage – capacity and expansion capabilities
- HI Infrastructure Plan status

A non-aligned member of this committee might easily be forced into the view that the process is deliberately focused towards the HBC objective of taking every opportunity to increase housing. If this is the case, as we believe it is, the Planning Head should be invited as a guest speaker to present the case for massive housing growth on Hayling Island.

We strongly insist that time is allocated at the 4th meeting to allow the non-aligned members to express their considered concerns on the process to date and deliverables and conclusions.

We all are charged with presenting the community with a visible and democratic analysis of the Island's future.
